DIRECTIONS FOR USE: SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING. This product has a special valve that sprays in all directions even upside down for hard to reach areas.

ON HOUSE PLANTS: Kills Aphids, Spotted Mites, Exposed Thrips, Leafhoppers, Climbing Cutworms, Caterpillars, Adult Whiteflies on Houseplants such as English Ivy, African Violets, Impatiens, Geraniums, Begonias.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Contents under pressure. Do not place in hot water or near radiators, stoves or other sources of heat. Do not puncture or incinerate container, or store at temperatures over 50°C. Do not spray closer than 1m. to fabric. Do not spray near open flame, spark or while smoking. Do not contaminate any body of water. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, and clothing. Avoid inhalation of spray. Wash after using. Keep from freezing. Do not use on Maidenhair ferns.

FIRST AID

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If swallowed: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

DISPOSAL: When container is empty, press valve to release all pressure. Wrap and dispose of empty container in household garbage.
